

This is a 2-year ACGME accredited clinical fellowship offered by the Department of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation of the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center (UPMC) and Children's Hospital Rehabilitation Institute.

Fellowship training is centered at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh (CHP), a level 1 trauma center and home to the Children's Hospital Rehabilitation Unit (CHRU).

Fellows rotate through a 2-year curriculum that includes training in:

- Inpatient comprehensive pediatric rehabilitation
- Inpatient pediatric rehabilitation consults
- Outpatient pediatric rehabilitation
- Pediatric subspecialties
- Pediatrics
- Research

Inpatient Experiences

Our fellows are fortunate to experience both quaternary care, children's hospital-based rehabilitation, and community-based rehabilitation.

Training in both settings is a unique feature of our training program.

CHRU is our 8-bed inpatient pediatric rehabilitation unit. PRM physicians lead a team of therapeutic and supportive services to improve function and medical outcomes.

We have a busy pediatric rehabilitation medicine consultative service at CHP where we assist our colleagues in evaluating and managing acute care needs and planning for post-acute care rehabilitation needs.

Outpatient Experiences

We provide rehabilitation services to thousands of children annually to improve their daily functioning and quality of life.

PRM fellows participate in specialty outpatient clinics and programs including:
