Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh of UPMC's Infusion Center is an outpatient service offered to pediatric patients who have intravenous care needs. As the region's only pediatric infusion center, it sees about 1,300 patients a year.

The Infusion Center contains private, curtained treatment areas that are equipped with a reclining lounge chair. TVs, Wi-Fi, books, and games are available. The suite provides privacy for the patient while allowing the nurse to conduct close monitoring and observation.

The Infusion Center provides accessible, convenient outpatient care for patients receiving regular IV infusion treatments for conditions including Crohn's disease, multiple sclerosis, and rheumatoid arthritis.

Treatments administered include intravenous gammaglobulin infusions (IVIG), Remicade, Tysabri, Synergys, Methotrexate, and Solu-Medrol.



The Infusion Center sees patients by appointment and with a physician's referral. Call 412-692-8927 or 412-692-8505 to refer.
