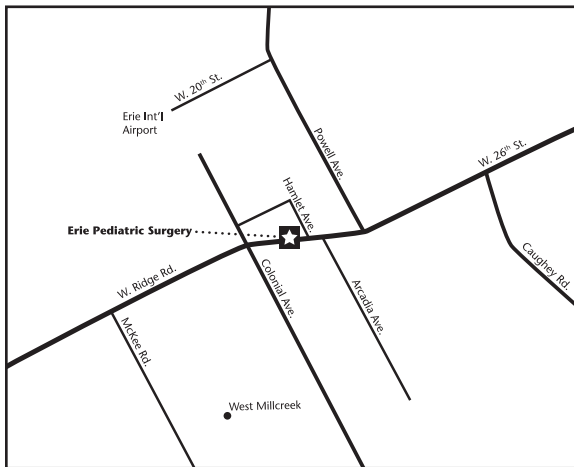

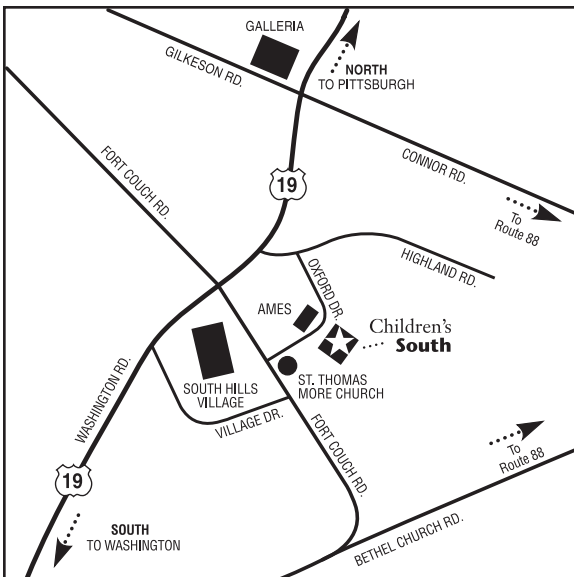
PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

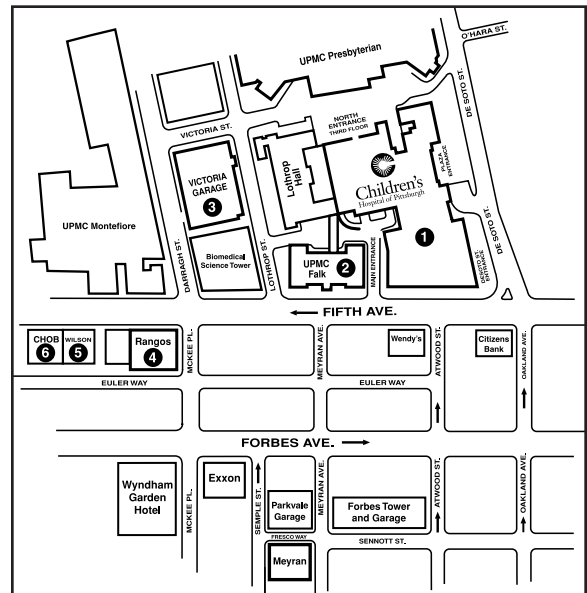
MAPS OF OUR OFFICES



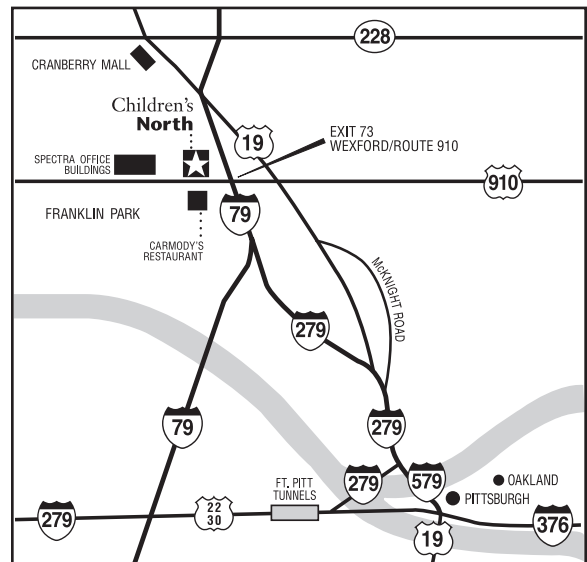

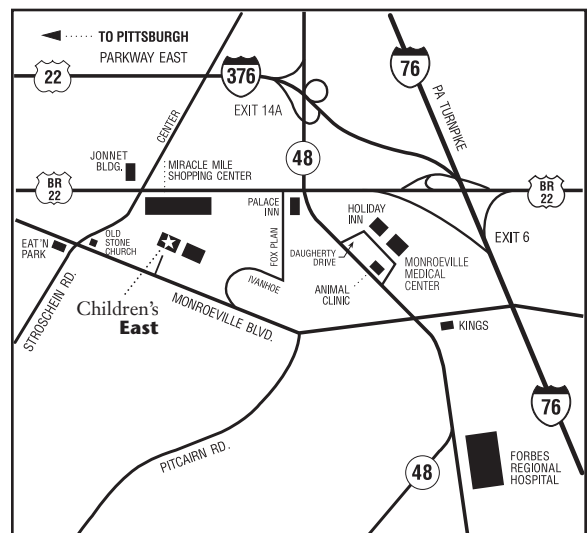
