

Port Authority Connections to the New Children's Hospital

This brochure is designed to help you adjust to your new morning and evening travel patterns to and from the new hospital.

While Port Authority has no immediate plans to redirect any existing bus service from Oakland to Lawrenceville, frequent service is available to the new hospital from Downtown Pittsburgh, Oakland, and East Liberty.

Please see the information listed below for connections to and from the new hospital.

Transferring in Downtown Pittsburgh

86B Frankstown provides the most direct service to the new hospital.

Board buses on:

Penn Avenue at 8th Street

Liberty Avenue at Wood Street T Station

Transferring in East Liberty (or from the East Busway)

86B Frankstown provides the most direct service to the new hospital.

Board buses at:

Penn Mall Station – Shelter #4

Exit East Busway express buses at East Liberty Station. Use orange pedestrian overpass to access Penn Mall Station.

Transferring in Oakland

54C Oakland-Strip District provides the most direct service to the new hospital.

Board buses along the Fifth Avenue bus lane, Forbes Avenue at the Carnegie Museum, or along Craig Street.

Other routes that have stops near the hospital are:

77D Highland-Friendship

77F Morningside-Friendship

77G Stanton Heights-Friendship

From Downtown Pittsburgh

Board buses on:

Smithfield Street at Sixth Avenue (Burlington)

Exit bus on Howley Street at Friendship Avenue and walk one block north on Friendship Avenue to hospital.

86A East Hills

From Downtown Pittsburgh

Board buses on:

Liberty Avenue at Wood Street T Station

Exit bus on Liberty Avenue at Ella Street, walk two blocks north on Main Street, turn right on Penn Avenue and continue one block to hospital.
