

Dear Patient.

You have alpha-1-antitrypsin deficiency (ATD) with liver involvement (i.e. cirrhosis and its complications) and have been referred to Robert H. Squires, MD, and the Liver Study team at UPMC. Your doctor's office contacted us indicating that you are interested in learning more about our Alpha-1 Research Study, which evaluates the effects and effectiveness of carbamazepine (CBZ) on ATD.

Dr. Squires or a member of the study team will call to discuss the Alpha-1 Study and answer your questions about participation. If you chose to participate, you must first complete the screening visit before you can enroll.

What to expect during screening:

- Review of the Informed Consent Form
- Medical History Review
- Physical Exam
- Blood Work

- EKG
- Abdominal Ultrasound
- Liver Biopsy
